

I was disappointed in this book. I did like the main character, Lizzie, and her love interest Will was appealing, but there was only the slightest nod towards romance. More frustrating was the constant backstory; it was difficult to tell where this book's plot was going because so much of the story was spent in describing secondary characters' situations from previous books. I agree that it was difficult to keep the characters straight, and I've read the previous books. Ireland was well pictured, but

that could not save this book from being a confusing, unromantic snooze.
